DAY 01: Overnight journey from Delhi/ Haridwar to Sonprayag Guptkashi

Day 1 Overnight journey from Delhi towards Sonprayag/ Guptkashi

- Meet and greet your fellow travelers and coordinator at Akshardham Metro Station between 10:00 - 11:30 PM.
- We'll be making a pit stop along the way for a delicious dinner, where you can indulge in your favorite dishes (self-paid).
- We'll embark on our overnight journey to Sonprayag / Guptkashi / Phata.

Day 2 Reach Phata/ Guptkashi | Overnight Stay

- Arrive at Guptkashi via Devprayag, with a brief stop to observe the Sangam of the Alaknanda and Bhagirathi rivers.
- Our route will take us through picturesque locations such as Byasi, Devprayag, Srinagar, Rudraprayag, and Agastmuni hill stations.
- Enjoy a leisurely lunch midway, and anticipate reaching our destination by evening.
- Upon arrival, check into the hotel and unwind for the evening.
- Depending on availability, settle in for the night at Guptkashi, Sonprayag, or Phata.

Day 3 Drive to Gaurikund | Kedarnath Trek

- Wake up early in the morning, freshen up, and enjoy a hearty breakfast before checking out from the hotel.
- Our journey continues as we drive to Gaurikund, the base point for the Kedarnath trek.
- Prepare for an exhilarating trek of 16 kilometers, approximately 7-8 hours long, to reach the sacred destination of Kedarnath by evening.
- Upon arrival, check into the guest house and immerse yourself in the spiritual atmosphere as you witness the live aarti at the highest abode of Lord Shiva.
- Indulge in a delicious dinner and settle in for an overnight stay in Kedarnath, with shared accommodations due to limited space availability.

Day 4 Kedarnath Temple Darshan | Overnight Stay

- Begin your day bright and early as we prepare for the sacred Kedarnath Dham Darshan.
- After checking out from our stay, we'll make our way to join the Darshan lines and seek the blessings of Kedarnath Ji.
- Following the divine Darshan, we'll trek back to Gaurikund and proceed towards Guptakashi.
- Anticipate reaching Guptakashi by nightfall, where we'll have dinner and settle in for a peaceful overnight stay.

Day 5 Guptkashi - Badrinath Temple | Overnight Stay

- Enjoy a delicious breakfast at the hotel in Guptkashi before we embark on our journey to Badrinath.
- Along the way, we'll take the opportunity for some sightseeing, soaking in the beauty of the surrounding landscapes.
- Upon reaching Badrinath Dham, we'll check into our hotel and prepare to attend the evening aarti, a serene and spiritually uplifting experience.
- Afterward, indulge in a hearty dinner and settle in for a peaceful overnight stay in Badrinath, surrounded by the tranquil vibes of this sacred place.

Day 6 Badrinath Temple Darshan and Depart from Delhi

- Wake up early to embrace the serene ambiance of Badrinath. Attend the morning aarti at Badrinath Temple, immersing yourself in the divine atmosphere.
- Afterward, enjoy a hearty breakfast and check out from the hotel.
- If time permits, we'll visit Mana village, the last Indian village, to immerse ourselves in its unique culture and charm.
- Before departing for Delhi, we'll take some time to visit additional sights and soak in the beauty of the surrounding areas.
- Finally, we'll begin our journey back to Delhi, carrying with us the memories and blessings from our spiritual pilgrimage to Badrinath.



- Both Side Transportation: From Delhi/ Rishikesh/ Haridwar to Kedarnath. (6D5N including travel time)
- Stays: 4N 5D
- Meals: 4 Breakfasts, 4 Dinners
- Starting from dinner in Guptkashi and ending with breakfast (Basic food will be provided as per the hill culture & trekking needs)
- Every day departure from Delhi (Minimum 6 persons)
- No room sharing is applicable at Kedarnath and Badrinath. Each person will get one bed, one pillow, and one blanket. Stays will be basic as per the remote area.
- Any cost arising due to natural calamities like landslides, roadblocks, etc., to be borne by the customer on the spot.
- Sightseeing depends on your time management and cooperation among your co-passengers.
- Coordinator Assistance

- Trekking (The Kedarnath Trek and Yatra Pass)
- Trek with guide to Kedarnath
- As it is a group tour, no stop will be conducted according to all group members' preferences.
- In case the yatra is interrupted during your trip, the company is not liable for arranging any extra expenses, stays, or anything that is not included in your trip plan.

- Personal Expenses
- Any cost arising due to Natural calamities like landslides, road blocks etc. (to be borne directly by the customer on the spot)
- Any personal expenses like tip to the Driver, entry to monuments/monasteries, camera /video charges, laundry, telephone bills, tips etc.
- Any kind of food & beverages that is not included in the package like alcohol, mineral water/refreshments etc.
- Anything not mentioned in the inclusions.

CANCELLATION POLICY

No Refund shall be made with respect to the initial booking amount for any cancellations. However,

- -> If cancellations are made 30 days before the start date of the trip, 50% of the trip cost will be charged as cancellation fees.
- -> If cancellations are made 15-30 days before the start date of the trip, 75% of the trip cost will be charged as cancellation fees.
- -> If cancellations are made within 0-15 days before the start date of the trip, 100% of the trip cost will be charged as cancellation fees.

In the case of unforeseen weather conditions or government restrictions, certain activities may be canceled and in such cases, the operator will try his best to provide an alternate feasible activity. However, no refund will be provided for the same.

TERMS & CONDITIONS

- Booking: All booking for the tours /treks are made with TRAVEXX, hereinafter referred to as 'the company', and are subject to the conditions: the person signing the booking form accepts the conditions and is hereafter referred to as the client.
- Liability: The Company cannot be made liable for the consequences of weather conditions, flight cancellations, war or threat of civil war, strikes, industrial action, political unrest, or any other force majeure, unusual or unforeseen circumstance. The company reserves the right to use alternate transport, or vary the itinerary if breakdown, sickness, or any other force major. Any additional result, such as extra hotel accommodation, flight or road transport will be on your charge and must be paid directly at the spot.
- Please understand, there are certain hazards involved in your adventurous and cultural holidays which you must accept at your own risk. The company will not be liable for any illness major or minor injury, death sustained during neither the trip, nor it will be liable for any uninsured losses of your property and other losses during the trip.

 authority and the decision of the tour/ trek leader or escort appointed by
 the company whilst on tour with the company. If in the opinion of the
 tour/ trek leader, any client's behavior is detrimental to the safety, welfare,
 or harmonious state of the group as a whole, the client may be asked to
 leave the tour/trek without any right of refund and all extra expenses
 caused will be on his/her charge.
- The organizers or any individual connected with the camp shall not be held responsible for any accident or any unforeseen natural calamity
- Last moment changes on the program will not be acceptable. The final decision on any dispute will be taken by TRAVEXX.
- Participants are expected to be in discipline. One can be dismissed from the program/camp who is found to be misbehaving with any individual or staff members, without prior notice.
