Day 1

Leh Arival

Arrive at Leh airport from which you will experience the beautiful rugged landscape of Ladakh as you make your way to the hotel. Today we spend the day relaxing.

Day 2

Leh Sightseeing

Today we will drive on the Leh Srinagar Highway (NH1). On the way we will stop at Gurudwara Pathersahib, Magnetic hill and Sangam (confluence of Indus and Zaskar river) in the evening we will visit 03 places around Leh city, Leh palace and Shanti stupa.

Day 3

Leh to Nubra

After breakfast, we will drive from Leh to Nubra Valley via Khardungla pass (9th highest motorable road in the world). Very scenic drive... rest at the hotel, in the evening, we will go to hunder sand dunes for camel riding. Some double humped camel of the silk route are still here, and if you are tired then we can do the camel riding the next day. (05 hours approx).

Day 4

Nubra – Turtuk – Nubra

After breakfast, we will drive from hunder to Turtuk valley. Visit 0 point... this is the last village of the Indian side. Pakistan border. Nice drive along the beautiful shayok river... walk around the village, lunch there... and return back to hunder...camel riding in the evening if haven't done in the day before.....rest (05 hours drive approx).

Day 5

Nubra to Pangong Lake

After breakfast, we will drive towards Pangong Lake via shayok route. On the way we will visit Diskit Monastery and the large Buddha statue.. nice drive along the Shayok river... (05 hours drive approx.)

Today, we camp under the stars at Pangong.

Day 6

Pangong to Leh

After breakfast, we will drive back to Leh via chang-la pass (02nd highest road in the world) While Coming back to Leh we will also Explore Rancho's School, Explore Leh Market in the Evening Have your Dinner and Bonfire. (05 hours approx.)

Day 7

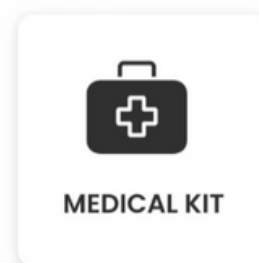
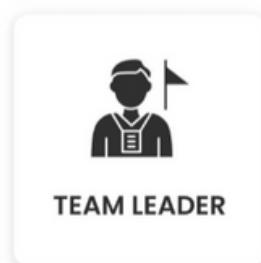
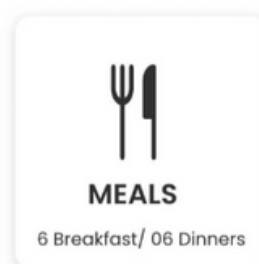
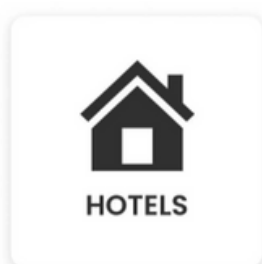
Depart from Leh

Inclusions

- Entire travel from Leh to Leh by tempo traveler (for Tempo opt)
- Bike Rent for 5 days - Day 2 till Day 8 (for Biking option)
- Fuel for the bike
- Stay for 6 nights - 3 nights in a hotel at Leh, 2 nights in a hotel Nubra Valley, 1 night in camps at Pangong Tso on triple sharing
- A total of 12 meals - 1 meal Day 1 (D) + 2 meals Day 2 (B+D) + 2 meals Day 3 (B+D) + 2 meals Day 4 (B+D) + 2 meals Day 5 (B+D) + 2 meals Day 6 (B+D) + 1 meal Day 7 (B)
- Mechanical Backup
- All inner Line permits for the trip
- Team captain throughout the trip
- Driver Night Charges, Toll Tax, Parking Charges, etc.
- Riding Gears (Though it is recommended you carry your own helmet for comfort)
- An oxygen Cylinder 24x7 in the car in case of emergency



Exclusion

- GST (5%) is applicable extra.
- Any kind of food or beverage that is not included in the package like alcoholic drinks, mineral water, meals/ refreshments/lunches on the highway.
- Any personal expense like a tip to the driver, entry to monuments/monasteries, camera/ video camera charges, camel safari, river rafting, laundry, telephone bills, etc.
- Any cost arising due to natural calamities like landslides, roadblocks etc. (to be borne directly by the customer on the spot)
- Anything not mentioned in the inclusions.
- Any damage to the bike expect engine damage must be borne by the client.

CANCELLATION POLICY

No Refund shall be made with respect to the initial booking amount for any cancellations. However,

-> If cancellations are made 30 days before the start date of the trip, 50% of the trip cost will be charged as cancellation fees.

-> If cancellations are made 15-30 days before the start date of the trip, 75% of the trip cost will be charged as cancellation fees.

-> If cancellations are made within 0-15 days before the start date of the trip, 100% of the trip cost will be charged as cancellation fees.

In the case of unforeseen weather conditions or government restrictions, certain activities may be canceled and in such cases, the operator will try his best to provide an alternate feasible activity. However, no refund will be provided for the same.

TERMS & CONDITIONS

- **Booking:** All booking for the tours /treks are made with TRAVEXX, hereinafter referred to as 'the company', and are subject to the conditions: the person signing the booking form accepts the conditions and is hereafter referred to as the client.
- **Liability:** The Company cannot be made liable for the consequences of weather conditions, flight cancellations, war or threat of civil war, strikes, industrial action, political unrest, or any other force majeure, unusual or unforeseen circumstance. The company reserves the right to use alternate transport, or vary the itinerary if breakdown, sickness, or any other force major. Any additional result, such as extra hotel accommodation, flight or road transport will be on your charge and must be paid directly at the spot.
- Please understand, there are certain hazards involved in your adventurous and cultural holidays which you must accept at your own risk. The company will not be liable for any illness major or minor injury, death sustained during neither the trip, nor it will be liable for any uninsured losses of your property and other losses during the trip.
- **Travel insurance:** This is mandatory for all clients traveling on any tour/ trek or independent itinerary arranged by us. You are responsible for obtaining adequate insurance covering expenses of unexpected as mentioned in the liability paragraph. the loss of baggage, medical expenses, helicopter (air or ground) rescue, injury, death, repatriation, cancellation, and curtailment of the itinerary.
- **The decision of Tour/trek leader or Guide:** The client agrees to accept the authority and the decision of the tour/ trek leader or escort appointed by the company whilst on tour with the company. If in the opinion of the tour/ trek leader, any client's behavior is detrimental to the safety, welfare, or harmonious state of the group as a whole, the client may be asked to leave the tour/trek without any right of refund and all extra expenses caused will be on his/her charge.
- The organizers or any individual connected with the camp shall not be held responsible for any accident or any unforeseen natural calamity
- Last moment changes on the program will not be acceptable. The final decision on any dispute will be taken by TRAVEXX.
- Participants are expected to be in discipline. One can be dismissed from the program/camp who is found to be misbehaving with any individual or staff members, without prior notice.
- All sightseeing and treks are by walk.
