DAY 06: AHARBAL WATERFALL AND PAHALGAM SIGHTSEEING – OVERNIGHT STAY AT PAHALGAM



- Overnight stay in GULMARG.




- Travel to Sonamarg, also known as the "Meadow of Gold,"famous for its glaciers and stunning landscapes.

- Overnight stay at a hotel in Srinagar






- Start your journey from Srinagar in the morning, ensuring an early departure to make the most of the day.

- Depart from dhoodhpatri to Aharbal, known for its enchanting waterfall. Enjoy the natural beauty and take memorable photographs.
- Continue your journey to
   Pahalgam, a town renowned for its
   lush greenery and scenic
   landscapes.
- Explore local attractions and relax in the serene environment.
- Overnight stay at a hotel in Pahalgam.



- Start your day early in the morning from Pahalgam.
- Arrive at Aru Valley, a scenic meadow surrounded by snow-capped mountains.
- Enjoy the pristine beauty and take a stroll around the meadows.
- Proceed to Betaab Valley, named after the Bollywood movie Betaab, which was shot here.
- Explore the lush green landscapes, and consider taking a short horse ride or pony ride.
- Have lunch, either as a picnic amidst the natural surroundings or at a local eatery in the vicinity
- Drive to Chandanwari, the starting point for the Amarnath Yatra pilgrimage.
- If interested, explore the beautiful landscapes and the Sheshnag River.
- Overnight journey houseboat.



- Wake up early morning to witness a mesmerizing sunrise.
- After having breakfast, head back to Jammu.
- It will take 7-8 Hours to reach Jammu.
- After reaching Jammu enjoy some leisure at the Local Café, and board the bus later in the night.

## **CANCELLATION POLICY**

No Refund shall be made with respect to the initial booking amount for any cancellations. However,

- -> If cancellations are made 30 days before the start date of the trip, 50% of the trip cost will be charged as cancellation fees.
- -> If cancellations are made 15-30 days before the start date of the trip, 75% of the trip cost will be charged as cancellation fees.
- -> If cancellations are made within 0-15 days before the start date of the trip, 100% of the trip cost will be charged as cancellation fees.

In the case of unforeseen weather conditions or government restrictions, certain activities may be canceled and in such cases, the operator will try his best to provide an alternate feasible activity. However, no refund will be provided for the same.

## **TERMS & CONDITIONS**
