Brief Itinerary

Day 0

Overnight journey from Delhi – Shimla

- Gather and Report at Delhi Kashmiri Gate/ RK Ashram and meet our trip captain.
- Depart for Shimla.
Overnight journey Delhi to Shimla.

Day 1

Shimla - Chitkul



- Reach Shimla early morning, and transfer into a tempo traveler for Chitkul.
- We will take a halt at Rock Tunnel (Kinnaur Gate) on our way.
- Travel along the Sutlej river from where you will take a right turn towards Chitkul following the Baspa river. Chitkul is the last inhabited village before the Indo-Tibetan border.
- Overnight stay and diner in Rakchham.

Day 2

Chitkul – Kalpa

- This morning, we will explore the Chitkul Village and spend some leisure time sitting by the riverside of Baspa river.
- Afterwards, leave for Kalpa and visit the Suicide Point.
- Check in at Kalpa Hotel. Dinner & overnight stay.

Day 3

Kalpa - Gue - Tabo

- Wake up in the morning with an astonishing view of Kinner Kailash. Check-out and head towards Khab Sangam (confluence of Satluj and Spiti rivers).
- In Gue village, we'll visit Gue Monastery where 550 years old Mummy is preserved.
- Reach Tabo by evening and check-in at your home stay.

Day 4

Tabo – Dhankar – Kaza

- Tabo is a very mystical village which has a history of more than 1,025 years. Visit the Tabo Monastery (India's oldest monastery) followed by Tabo Caves.
- We'll head to Dhankar Monastery on the way to Kaza (Headquarter of Spiti).
- Reach Tabo by evening and check-in at you home stay.

Day 5

Kaza – Hikkim – Key – Komi – Langza

- We will visit the famous Key monastery which is built on a mountain hill. Then we will go to Hikkim (world's highest Post Office) and post letters to your loved ones.
- Then move to Konic (world's highest village connected with Motorable road) and finally explore Langza (Fossil village of India).
- Afterwards, we will have a small walk in the town and observe the scenic beauty of Kaza.

Day 6

Kaza – Chicham – Kunzum – Chandrataal

- This morning marks our last day in Kaza. On this day we have to check-out early. We will hit the roads to Kunzum ass via Chicham bridge (Asia's highest suspension bridge).
- Then move towards Chandrataal, check-in our camps and visit the Chandrataal lake.

Day 7

Chandrataal – Manali – Delhi

- Reach Delhi with a lot of memories by morning.
- Hold those memories strongly because you can't go back to that same trip experiencing the impulses of life at the same time!
- **NOTE: WILL REACH DELHI AROUND 6-8AM.**

Day 7

Chandrataal – Manali – Delhi

- Wake up relaxed in the morning today and have breakfast with a majestic view. Post breakfast we will have some photographs clicked and some insta reels before we leave for Manali and have an over night Volvo journey to Delhi.
- We will be in Delhi by approx 11 A.M. on Sunday.

Inclusions

- Stay for 6 nights - 1 night in hotel at Rakchham, 1 night in hotel at Kalpa, 1 night in home stay at Tabo, 2 nights in home stay at Kaza & 1 night in Swiss Camps with attached washroom at Chandrataal.
- Delhi to Shimla Volvo ticket, Shimla to Kaza to Manali tempo traveler, Manali to Delhi Volvo ticket.
- Entry tickets in all Monasteries.
- Driver night charges, Toll tax, Pa charges, etc.
- An Oxygen cylinder 24x7 in the car in case of emergencies.

Exclusion

- 5% GST
- Extra Drinks, Food, Tea and Snacks.
- Tickets for any sightseeing or extra activity outside the camp area.
- Travel Insurance and other benefits.
- Anything which is not mentioned in inclusions.
- Cost escalation due to any unforeseen reason like weather, road condition landslide etc.

CANCELLATION POLICY

No Refund shall be made with respect to the initial booking amount for any cancellations. However,

-> If cancellations are made 30 days before the start date of the trip, 50% of the trip cost will be charged as cancellation fees.

-> If cancellations are made 15-30 days before the start date of the trip, 75% of the trip cost will be charged as cancellation fees.

-> If cancellations are made within 0-15 days before the start date of the trip, 100% of the trip cost will be charged as cancellation fees.

In the case of unforeseen weather conditions or government restrictions, certain activities may be canceled and in such cases, the operator will try his best to provide an alternate feasible activity. However, no refund will be provided for the same.

TERMS & CONDITIONS

- **Booking:** All booking for the tours /treks are made with TRAVEXX, hereinafter referred to as 'the company', and are subject to the conditions: the person signing the booking form accepts the conditions and is hereafter referred to as the client.
- **Liability:** The Company cannot be made liable for the consequences of weather conditions, flight cancellations, war or threat of civil war, strikes, industrial action, political unrest, or any other force majeure, unusual or unforeseen circumstance. The company reserves the right to use alternate transport, or vary the itinerary if breakdown, sickness, or any other force major. Any additional result, such as extra hotel accommodation, flight or road transport will be on your charge and must be paid directly at the spot.
- Please understand, there are certain hazards involved in your adventurous and cultural holidays which you must accept at your own risk. The company will not be liable for any illness major or minor injury, death sustained during neither the trip, nor it will be liable for any uninsured losses of your property and other losses during the trip.
- **Travel insurance:** This is mandatory for all clients traveling on any tour/ trek or independent itinerary arranged by us. You are responsible for obtaining adequate insurance covering expenses of unexpected as mentioned in the liability paragraph. the loss of baggage, medical expenses, helicopter (air or ground) rescue, injury, death, repatriation, cancellation, and curtailment of the itinerary.
- **The decision of Tour/trek leader or Guide:** The client agrees to accept the authority and the decision of the tour/ trek leader or escort appointed by the company whilst on tour with the company. If in the opinion of the tour/ trek leader, any client's behavior is detrimental to the safety, welfare, or harmonious state of the group as a whole, the client may be asked to leave the tour/trek without any right of refund and all extra expenses caused will be on his/her charge.
- The organizers or any individual connected with the camp shall not be held responsible for any accident or any unforeseen natural calamity
- Last moment changes on the program will not be acceptable. The final decision on any dispute will be taken by TRAVEXX.
- Participants are expected to be in discipline. One can be dismissed from the program/camp who is found to be misbehaving with any individual or staff members, without prior notice.
