## Day I Departure from Delhi

Meet at the meeting point in Delhi Kashmiri gate/ R K Ashram 30 min Prior to the Boarding Time(9 PM).
Overnight journey from Delhi to Shimla in volvo.

## Day 2 Shimla to Chitkul

- After early breakfast drive via Kufri, Narkanda,and descend to the Rampur, further drive toSangla, the majesty of the Kinner Kailashmountain is in direct vision.
- Visit a village and temple built in typical Kinnauriarchitecture.
- Stay in Sangla , night in Hotel/ Homestay



- Wake up early morning to witness amesmerizing sunrise. After havingbreakfast, head towards Chhitkul
- We pass through some more stunninglandscapes and reach Chhitkul byafternoon.
- After some leisure, enjoy the sunset nearthe Baspa River.
- Next, you will be departing for Kaza. Passingby the Spiti River, enjoy 360- a degree viewof the mesmerizing snowclad mountains.Stay in Nako.

#### Day 4 Nako to Tabo

- Wake up early morning to witness amesmerizing sunrise. After having breakfast,head towards Tabo.
- In between, you will be covering Gue monastery .
- Next, you will be departing for Tabo. Passing bythe Spiti River, enjoy 360- a degree view of themesmerizing snow-clad mountains. We will visitTabo Monastery.
- Overnight stay at Tabo



- After breakfast, start your Journey towards Kaza.
- We will visit Dhankar Monastery on the way.
- Enjoy the breathtaking views from Dhankar Village.
- Reach Kaza, by evening, check in to your homestayand have Dinner..

### Day 6 Kaza Exploration

- Wake up early morning to witness a mesmerizingsunrise. Today is the day to explore the Spiti region.
- After breakfast, we start visiting the highestvillages of Spiti starting with Langza village, Hikkimvillage (the highest post office in the altitude), andKomic the highest village.
- Exploring it will consume your whole day in theupper region of Spiti valley.
- Return back to Kaza in the evening for Dinner &Stay.



- After breakfast starts your journey towardsShimla, Stay in Kalpa, the village built in typicalKinnauri architecture.
- If time allows you can take a short drive on oldHindustanTibet Road where locate the suicidepoint, One of the attractions due to its sheercliffy road.
- Back to Kalpa, night in Hotel.

# Day 8 Kalpa to Delhi via Shimla

- Wake up early morning to witness amesmerizing sunrise.
- After having breakfast, head back to Shimla Aftersome leisure at the Mall road(if time permits)
- Visit the local Shimla on our own and board thebus later in the night

#### **CANCELLATION POLICY**

No Refund shall be made with respect to the initial booking amount for any cancellations. However,

-> If cancellations are made 30 days before the start date of the trip, 50% of the trip cost will be charged as cancellation fees.

-> If cancellations are made 15-30 days before the start date of the trip, 75% of the trip cost will be charged as cancellation fees.

-> If cancellations are made within 0-15 days before the start date of the trip, 100% of the trip cost will be charged as cancellation fees.

In the case of unforeseen weather conditions or government restrictions, certain activities may be canceled and in such cases, the operator will try his best to provide an alternate feasible activity. However, no refund will be provided for the same.
